

PUBLIC HEARING
2014 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS
BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG

Gettysburg Borough Council will hold the second of two public hearings on Monday, November 10, 2014 at 6:45 PM in Council Chambers of the Borough Building, 59 East High Street, Gettysburg, PA, in order to undertake another review of \$110,601.00 in Fiscal Year 2014 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. Up to 18 percent of CDBG funds may be used for program administration.

A wide number of activities may be undertaken with CDBG funds including but not limited to public service; public facilities and improvements, which includes improved access for Americans with Disabilities; and architectural barrier removal.

CDBG funds are provided to the Borough on an annual basis through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development and administered in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania by the state Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED). They are intended to fund projects and programs that directly benefit low-moderate income residents of the Borough. To be considered, all funding requests must meet a National Objective of the CDBG Program, and be an eligible and fundable activity. Citizens may also comment on the Borough's prior use of CDBG funds. The Borough of Gettysburg will make all reasonable attempts to accommodate language access needs of residents requesting oral translation during citizen participation activities.

Borough Council anticipates making final approval of the CDBG application by no later than at its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, December 8, 2014 for submission to DCED.
