
Chairman Alice Estrada opened the first of two required public hearings for the 2012 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) application at 4:00 pm. Scott Dellett reported that the hearing had been advertised in the *Gettysburg Times* as required. He also reported that letters were sent to six non-profit agencies noting that the Borough intended to use any CDBG funds awarded to the Borough for ADA ramps and sidewalk replacement where necessary and therefore was not soliciting proposals from other agencies. The Borough has made a long-term commitment to correcting outstanding ADA issues.

Scott Dellett announced that the amount of CDBG money that will be available to the Borough is \$107,043.

A second public hearing will be scheduled before the May 14, 2012 Borough Council meeting.

After a call for public comment went unanswered, Chairman Estrada closed the hearing at 4:08 pm.
